President and Mr. Bogaram Nath, M.A., B.T. founder Principal & Secretary along with groups of learned people including Sri Krishna Chandra Deva Goswami, then Satradhikar of Garamur Satra had played key role in its foundation.

Rangachahi College is located only twelve kilometers away from Garmur, the district head quarter of Majuli and lies in the heart of this river locked Island.

Botanical Garden, Heritage Museum and Yoga Centre are the special wings of College which inspire the students for co-curriculum activities and this helps to build up the Indian values especially like scientific temper, awareness on protection of environments, heritage, conservation, health and mental development, cooperation, feeling of brotherhood, mutual understanding and all other values of our society.

Medium of Instruction:

The medium of instruction of the college is Assamese and English

Library:

Library helps to explore the knowledge and wisdom. The college is rich with more than *fifteen thousand five hundred books* on diverse fields and subjects. In addition to these, daily newspapers, magazines and journals are well supplied to keep the students updated. Both the students and the teachers have the opportunities to borrow books as per the library rules. The college authority has already built up a well-equipped digitalized library to meet hopes and aspirations of the learned community of this locality.

Hostel Accommodation:

Hostel accommodation is available at the College. Basically for girl students, the college accommodates well equipped two R.C.C. Girls' Hostel facilities with separate dining room and spacious sanitation.

Games and Sports:

Rangachahi College has been providing facilities for the overall development of students. As such, college has both outdoor and indoor games facilities along with a spacious play ground of standard size in a sweet environment surrounding shady trees and plantation. Rangachahi College, with the collaboration of local '*Krira Association*' popularly known as '*Rangachahi Krira Santha*' conducts annually football and cricket competition in the college field in the memory of distinguished personalities. Besides, '*College Week*' provides an opportunity for the betterment of students in the fields of cultures, games and sports.

Admission Procedure:

As per the guidelines of Assam Higher Secondary Education Council (AHSEC) and Dibrugarh University, students are admitted at the Higher Secondary and Under Graduate. For admission in to various courses, certificates required are - *Examination Passed Certificates, Mark sheets and other academic documents*. For major courses, every department conducts selection tests in due time. Admission forms and other information are notified timely from the office of the principal of Rangachahi College and NEP 2020 concerned.

Attendance:

75% attendance is mandatory for every student. The college authority strictly ensures regular attendance of students of all classes. The college authority has the provision of declaring dis-Collegiate, non-collegiate and regular students on the basis of percentage of class attendance for appearing in Higher Secondary and Degree Examinations conducted by the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council and Dibrugarh University respectively.

Identity Card:

Identity Card is provided to the regular students by the College authority for their specific identity, security and disciplined social position.

Scholarships and Awards:

Late Bogaram Nath Memorial Lecture:

A Memorial Lecture has been initiated from this year in honour of Late Bogaram Nath, Founder Principal of the College. The lecture will be delivered every year on 9th April.

Student Aid Fund:

Rangachahi College has a Student Aid Fund to help the students who are economically poor, needy and physically handicapped. Also, students are helped economically in their serious diseases and in other unexpected incidents from the fund according to its fund-position.

Students' Uniform:

In order to strengthen uniformity and equality among the student communities and to remove the feelings of economic disparities the college authorities have introduced compulsory uniform. For boys the uniform is white shirt, black pant and black sweater; for the girls white pants, white colour shirt and black sweater & Green *churni*.

Students' Council:

Rangachahi College Students' Council is an integral part of the college. The council protects the interest of the student community maintaining close relation with the authority, teachers and employees of the college. The members of the Students' Council are elected through democratic procedures.

College Examinations:

It is compulsory for all students to appear in the test, terminal, unit test and sessional examinations conducted by the college authority from time to time. Absence in such examination violates the college rules and such students may be placed under non-collegiate /dis-collegiate categories.

Students' Magazine:

The Students' Council annually publishes a Magazine entitled '*Jyoti Konch*' that provides the golden opportunity for the students to develop their literary talents.

Canteen Facility:

Comfortable Canteen facility is available within the College Campus.

IQAC:

The IQAC monitors the overall activities of the College. The College has been awarded 'B' Grade by the *National Assessment and Accredited Council (NAAC)* in 2017. There are several sub-committees under the IQAC that have been working regularly the assigned responsibilities.

National Service Scheme (NSS):

The National Service Scheme (NSS) provides an opportunity for the students to develop their personalities and sense of social responsibilities through community services among the people.

SWAYAM:

SWAYAM seeks to bridge the digital divide for students who have hitherto remained untouched by the digital revolution and have not been able to join the mainstream of the knowledge economy. Under SWAYAM a Massive Open Online Courses will be offered in the Colleges as per the directive of the MHRD and UGC.

Women's Cell:

The lady teachers look after the problems of the Girl students and also conduct awareness campaign on various social issues among the women folks of the nearby villages.

College Health and Sanitation Club:

The members of this club stress upon maintain health and hygiene within the College premises and also conduct awareness campaigns in this regard in the nearby villages.

Gym Facilities:

The College has Gym facilities with modern equipment both for teachers and students opening daily during college hours.

Yoga:

Yoga classes for both Teachers and Students are held regularly in the campus to maintain sound mental and physical health as well as to aware the new generations of its importance in the stressful modern world.
